#### **Vocations Advocate**

The Office of Priestly and Religious Vocations coordinates the following areas of ministry for the Archdiocese of Indianapolis: Vocations Promotion and Discernment; Seminarian Applications; and Seminary Formation and Education.

Vocations Advocates volunteer in collaboration with the priests, deacons, pastoral staff members, school faculty and staff, and lay faithful of their parish in promoting vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life.

Vocations Advocates serve as the local representatives of the Office of Priestly and Religious Vocations. The goal of the Advocate program is to be a direct line of communication between the Office of Priestly and Religious Vocations and the parishes. This connection will foster a culture of vocations awareness by supporting the parishes with vocations resources and serving as an avenue for marketing and promotions of vocation events and activities.

#### **Volunteer Description**

- Promote Vocations to the priesthood, consecrated life, sacred married life, and sacred single life in your parish community
- Serve as a connecting link between the Vocations Office and the Parish
- Distribute promotional materials in the parish
- Communicate with parish representative to place announcements in parish bulletins, websites, or social media sites. (You are not responsible for the creation of materials, just distribution)
- Communicate with the Office of Priestly and Religious Vocations about local vocations efforts

#### **Requirements**

- Active membership in local parish community
- Ability to send/receive email
- Ability to print, or arrange for printing, of promotional materials such as a flyer
- Support of the pastor or PLC
