- ☞ Personal Invitations
- ☞ Involvement in youth and young adult groups

Encouragement to consider priesthood



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- ☞ Parish priest – 71%
 - ☞ Friend – 45%
 - ☞ Parishioner – 43%
 - ☞ Mother – 38%
 - ☞ Father – 28%
 - ☞ Teacher/Catechist – 23%
